Use the grid below to construct a picture. It doesn't have to use so many pixels! Think carefully about the colours you intend to use – black and white is easiest. Once you have coloured your squares, write the code for the pixels. When you have written the pixel code, think about the File Header that will need to go before it. Finally, write your code in Notepad. Save it with the right extension and render it in GIMP.
